- Answer customer questions about menu ingredients and dietary constraints
- Coordinate with client contacts at the event use judgment to determine on-site logistics
- Clean up thoroughly at the event and unload and wash dishes at the kitchen after events
- Communicate customer questions and feedback, along with your own observations and feedback, to management to help improve Street Treats

Requirements

- Previous customer service experience preferred, but not required

- Ability to stand for long hours and lift up to 50 lbs
- No planned absences longer than 7 days in a row from mid-June through mid-September
